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HEALTHCARE in FOCUS

Two large grants this quarter went to hospitals. The Foundation is supporting the Mary Free Bed Rehabilitation Hospital's Pediatric Programming expansion with a \$250,000 grant, payable over three years. Additions will include the launch of an Autism Program, Pediatric Pain Program and expansion of their Cerebral Palsy Programing. This new work targets some of the most prevalent childhood disorders and conditions.



The Foundation is also supporting Pine Rest Christian Mental Health Hospital with a \$150,000 three-year grant for their Flexible Care Inpatient Unit for adolescents and young adults. The expansion of Pine Rest's Van Andel Center enables them to care for an additional 1,200 youth annually in need of short-term intensive psychiatric hospitalization.

The other large grant this quarter was a \$250,000 three-year capital grant to WCSG Cornerstone radio. A much-needed new home for the station equipment and personnel is to become a reality in 2019. WCSG offers locally hosted, commercial free Christian programming.

Impact Items



The Board approved grants to 24 organizations totaling \$1,059,400 in Q3 2018. Grants ranged from \$1,000 to \$250,000.
